

Questions to Ask Your Doctor about a **Health Problem**

But what questions should you ask? If you're visiting your doctor to talk about a health problem, here's a list of questions you can print and bring to your appointment.

Don't forget, making sure you understand the answers you get is just as important. It's always a good idea to take notes. And if you don't understand or are confused, ask your doctor to explain the answer again.

- What is my diagnosis?
- Will I need any more tests?
- What are my treatment options?
- How soon do I need to make a decision about treatment?
- How much does my treatment cost?
- Is my treatment covered by insurance?

- Are there any side effects?
- What happens if I choose to not have treatment?
- What is the outlook for my future (prognosis)?
- Will I need special help at home?
